

HIPPA Privacy Policy

We take your privacy seriously. We want to tell you about our privacy practices to protect your personal health information.

Examples of how we use your information include:

- ⬇ Communicate with your insurance carrier, other healthcare providers for treatment, payment, or dental services.
- ⬇ Inform you of dental services and help you with your dental plan-when requested.
- ⬇ Communicate with family or friends that are involved in your care.
- ⬇ Communication with your dental plan.

There are limited times when we are permitted or required to disclose health information without your signed permission. These situations are listed below:

- ⬇ For judicial or administrative proceedings.
- ⬇ If required by law or law enforcement.
- ⬇ To protect victims of abuse or neglect for federal and state health oversight activities such as fraud investigations.
- ⬇ To Worker's Compensation if you are injured at work.
- ⬇ To coroners, medical examiners and funeral directors.

All other uses and disclosures, not previously described, may only be made with your signed authorization. You may revoke your authorization at any time. You have the right to request that we restrict how we use or disclose your health information. You may also request that we use a specific telephone number or address to communicate with you.

We do not give your financial or health information to any person or persons without your knowledge. It is important to us that you understand that the information we gather and how we use it is completely private.

Our goal continues to be one of providing the best possible care for our patients and protecting your personal health information.
